

# Anti-Trust Compliance & Fair Competition Commitment

BFI Employees and all BFI's business partners are reminded that they **should not**:

- Discuss or exchange information on individual prices, purchase prices, the terms of purchases among the competitors.
- Discuss any information on production or distribution cost (unless these data are historical and have already been published), action or strategies to manage market, supply, demand, recovery or other conditions that affect competition / supply chain arrangement.
- Enter into any secret deals or agreements with competitors regarding the prices, bids, profit margins, price differentials, mark-ups, discounts, allowance or credit terms. This also extends to BFI's future production, sales, inventory levels, market shares, allocation of customers or sales territories or the exclusion of Business Partners.
- Disclose information of any future plans, strategies, investments unless previously publicly announced.
- Coordinate tenders or bid-rigging.

It is always the responsibility of each participant to act in accordance with their own anti-trust compliance and/or fair competition policies.
